Arriving at school

- ▶ Week 1/2 (7th/14th Sept) 9.15- 11.15am
- ▶ Week 3 (21st Sept) 9.15 -11.45am
- ▶ Week 4 (28th Sept) 8.30 – 1.30pm
- ▶ Children come straight in via classroom door
- ▶ Hang up your coat and lunch bag on your peg.
- ▶ Sit on the carpet .

Independence

- ▶ P1 is about building confidence and self esteem
- ▶ Encourage your child to come in on their own
- ▶ Let them take off their coat and get their belongings out of their bags
- ▶ Practise taking off and putting on coats, jumpers and shoes at home
- ▶ Practise turn taking and sharing at home
- ▶ Ask them about their day

Literacy

- ▶ No reading books to be sent home – to be reviewed in light of Covid19
- ▶ Emphasis on language and preparation for reading
- ▶ Listening skills – can they concentrate?
- ▶ Auditory memory – can they recall names, numbers or colours?
- ▶ Visual memory – recall pictures or objects?
- ▶ Visual discrimination – same /different, focussing on size, colour, shape
- ▶ Syllables- tapping out names etc.
- ▶ Rhyme – can they recognise rhyming words or generate rhyming words?
- ▶ Initial sounds in words –can they hear the sounds, say them and recognise them?
- ▶ Segmenting / blending – sounding out words and putting them together

Numeracy

- ▶ Lots of practical games and activities
- ▶ Before Christmas focus on numbers 1-6 and 1-10 in P1
- ▶ Concepts – big/little/middle-size, same/different, more/less, 2D/3D shapes and estimation
- ▶ Sorting
- ▶ Pattern work
- ▶ Focus on independence, turn taking and sharing
- ▶ Writing numbers

- ▶ RE
- ▶ PDMU – Personal development and Mutual Understanding
- ▶ Music
- ▶ World Around Us
 - Me /Ourselves
 - Houses and Homes
 - Transport

Play Based Learning

- ▶ In P1 children take part in structured play each morning
- ▶ Structured play activities are planned around a topic
- ▶ Each child will experience the different areas of play
 - Sand / water
 - Creative
 - Small world
 - Construction
 - Role play
 - Malleable/ play dough

PE

- ▶ PE will start wk. beginning 28th September
- ▶ We have PE on Monday and Friday
- ▶ Please make sure your child has suitable footwear and a coat as PE will be outside in light of Covid19
- ▶ No jewellery is to be worn including hoop earrings
- ▶ During PE sessions children will explore spatial awareness, develop their coordination skills and improve gross and fine motor skills.

Uniform

- ▶ It is important that all children wear school uniform
- ▶ Have appropriate footwear
- ▶ All coats, cardigans and sweatshirts to be labelled
- ▶ No jewellery including hoop /stud earrings
- ▶ Please send your child with a coat and other appropriate clothes, gloves, hat etc. as we try to go outside in all weather

- ▶ Please send in a healthy snack each day with your child
- ▶ School dinners will not be available immediately
- ▶ Dinners will cost £2.60 per day or £13 a week please, a cashless system is currently being put in place and information will follow ASAP

 - Please ensure any fruit is peeled, cut and ready to eat as we cannot assist with this
