#### Arriving at school

## Independence

- ▶ P1 is about building confidence and self esteem
- Encourage your child to come in on their own
- Let them take off their coat and get their belongings out of their bags
- Practise taking off and putting on coats, jumpers and shoes at home
- Practise turn taking and sharing at home
- Ask them about their day

## Literacy

- ▶ No reading books to be sent home to be reviewed in light of Covid19
- Emphasis on language and preparation for reading
- Listening skills can they concentrate?
- Auditory memory can they recall names, numbers or colours?
- Visual memory recall pictures or objects?
- Visual discrimination same /different, focussing on size, colour, shape
- Syllables- tapping out names etc.
- Rhyme can they recognise rhyming words or generate rhyming words?
- Initial sounds in words –can they hear the sounds, say them and recognise them?
- Segmenting / blending sounding out words and putting them together

## Numeracy

- Lots of practical games and activities
- Before Christmas focus on numbers 1-6 and 1-10 in P1
- Concepts big/little/middle-size, same/different, more/less, 2D/3D shapes and estimation
- Sorting
- Pattern work
- Focus on independence, turn taking and sharing
- Writing numbers
